Parents must sign and date the completed Enrollment Form/Report prior to or on their child's first day claimed on the Child Care Food Program. If the parent signs and dates after the first day claimed on the Child Care Food Program, the date signed will determine the first day the provider will be reimbursed for the child's meals. Please remember to mail your Enrollment Forms/Reports to the office within 5 working days of the child's first day claimed on the Child Care Food Program.
